Saint Joseph Church, Camden is the diocesan pilgrimage site during this Year of Saint Joseph. Parishioners are invited to travel to this historic church

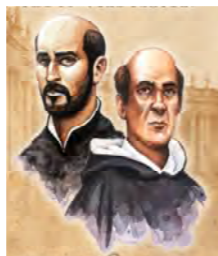

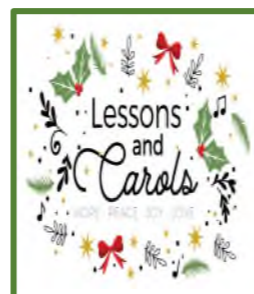
