#### **Anointing of the Sick**

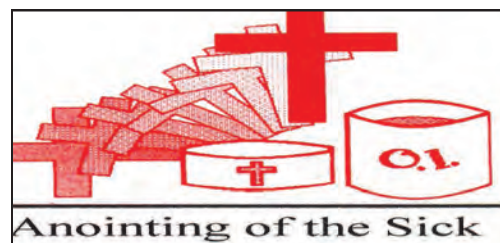
Mass of the Anointing of the Sick: In the Sacrament of the *Anointing of the Sick*, we pray that the sick will be healed in body, in soul and in spirit. Christ, during His life, often visited and healed the sick and loved them in their illness. If you or a family member are suffering from a serious illness or infirmity and would like to join us, you are most welcome. The Church teaches that the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick can be administered to:

- ▶ Those with a chronic illness
- ▶ Sick children if they have sufficient use of reason to be comforted by the sacrament
- ▶ Those preparing for surgery
- ▶ The elderly and homebound
- ▶ Those suffering from mental illness, depression or addiction

This Sacrament brings the healing strength of the Lord. Sometimes His healing comes by way of the person accepting their condition and relying on God's graces.

All parishioners are invited to attend the Anointing Mass! After Mass, light refreshments will be provided.

## THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER, APRIL 10, 2016

### Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

#### Excerpt from the Gospel for the Fourth Sunday of Easter, April 17, 2016 – John 10: 27-30

Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one can take them out of the Father's hand. The Father and I are one."

#### Commentary:

Consider the folks who have led you to become who you are today: family members and first teachers, mentors and heroes, friends, and maybe a few enemies along the way. You may have followed the inspiration of an idea or a dream, or received your greatest encouragement from people you only met in books or learned about from history. In ways we may scarcely be aware of, we have also been led by the small, still voice of our Creator, calling us to a greater and fuller life. If we have been raised in the Christian tradition, we also have been listening to the good news of Jesus Christ down through the years. Though we may stray after our demons from time to time, we can always find our way back to the center if we listen for the voice of Jesus. He calls us to our most authentic selves and tells us who we really are. Even when we are out finding ourselves, we are already found in his hands.

#### Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Reflection resonates with me?



We must remember that violence breeds violence. When we, as a nation, tolerate unjust attacks upon the tiniest innocents among us by abortion we accustom ourselves to violence. And so we have allowed these barbaric practices to corrupt our laws, our medical practice, and even our ordinary lives...the inhumanity of abortion affects the lives of all of us.

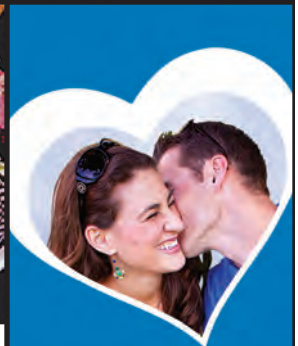

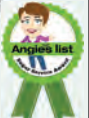
