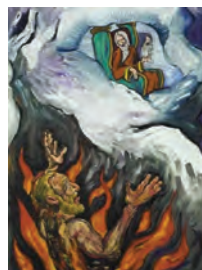

**Stewardship Reflection: 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Stewards Bridge Chasm**

*“ My child, remember that you received what was good during your lifetime, while Lazarus received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented. Moreover between us and you a great chasm is established.... ”*

*Luke 16: 25-26a*

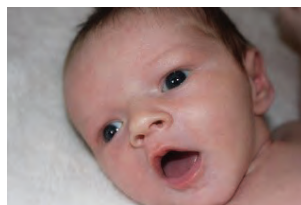

### Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

#### Excerpt from the Gospel for the Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 2, 2016 Luke 17: 5-10

"The Apostles said to the Lord, 'Increase our faith' The Lord replied, 'If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea and it would obey you. Who among you would say to your servant. Who has just come in from plowing or tending sheep in the field, 'Come here immediately and take your place at table?' Would he rather not say to him, 'Prepare something for me to eat. Put on your apron and wait on me while I eat and drink. You may eat and drink when I am finished.' Is he grateful to that servant because he did what was commanded? So should it be with you. When you have done all you have been commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants, we have done what we were obliged to do.'"

#### Commentary

In the Gospel reading, the disciples ask for an increase in faith. Jesus is saying they do not need to be heroes. An ordinary amount of trust in God's help will help them accomplish great things. Transplanting a mulberry tree into the sea is an highly exaggerated example. It serves, however, to make the point, "what is impossible for human beings is possible for God." Luke 18: 27

#### Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Commentary resonates with me?

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
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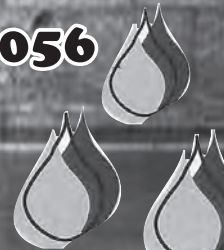
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
