SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER - JUNE 5, 2011

The pastor of both parishes will always be there to help you find transformation on your spiritual path. He will always be there in times of sadness and in times of joy. He will be an agent of comfort and an agent of hope. He will help you live more fully and live with greater joy.

The pastor of both parishes will be there to help you dispel anxiety and create inner calm along the way. He will be there to help you explore mind-body health for yourself. He will always be there day and night to help you find meaning in life and find meaning in death.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners retain their identity, their integrity and their personality, traits and unique history.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners retain their worship site with Sunday Mass, daily Mass, prayer services and their buildings and their assets.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More Parishioners support the Liturgy Committee, the Music Ministry and the Art and Environment Committee and everything that enhances our liturgies, our worship and praise of God the Father.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners retain their Deacon, Pastoral Associate for Life Long Faith Formation, Pastoral Associate for Parish Administration, their Coordinator of Religious Education, their Parish Secretary and other staff members that are necessary for the daily operational and pastoral needs of the parish.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners retain their Parish Pastoral Council, their Finance Council and their present budgeting and accounting system. The parish continues to have its independent banking arrangements. The parish continues to elect two lay parishioners as corporate trustees and their present corporation status.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More Parishioners continue to support all lay leadership of ministry along with the many volunteers and engaged parishioners who are our greatest treasure.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners will continue their high level of care and commitment to caring for the sick, homebound and dying.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More Parishioners continue to see the supreme importance of Small Christian Communities. These small groups create the systematic intentional structures necessary to deliver adult faith formation and promote the overarching theme of evangelization.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners continue; to support the Religious Education of our young people; to support Adult Faith Formation; to support Youth Ministry; to support the St. Vincent de Paul Society; to support the Women's Club; to support the Bereavement Ministry; to support the Prayer Shawl Ministry, and the Funsters.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners have the financial responsibility for the maintenance and upkeep of all the buildings and parish grounds.

In the cluster model, St. Thomas More parishioners will continue to support all parish organizations and activities that continue to evangelize and build up the Body of Christ in this East side of Cherry Hill. Blessings,

SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER - JUNE 5, 2011

Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

We put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for the proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

Excerpt from the Gospel for Pentecost Sunday, June 12, 2011 - John 20:19-23

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained."

Commentary:

Imagine that you're home at night, the door locked, the day's responsibilities safely tucked away until tomorrow. Into the room walks Jesus. You don't know how he got there, but you know it's he. "Peace be with you," he says. As well he might, since you're about ready to jump out of your skin. Then he delivers these notentirely-comforting operating instructions: "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." That's sort of what you were afraid he'd say, to be honest. You've read the book so you already know where the Father sent him. And yes, the book has a happy ending or you wouldn't be standing here having this conversation with the Risen Lord. Do you have enough trust to put your hand in the hand of a man marked deep with sacred wounds? He's waiting for your answer.

Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

- 1. How do you feel personally challenged by the message of Pentecost? What will you do in response?
- 2. Think of a time when you felt bound by someone's unforgiveness or your own. Describe how you felt when you were forgiven or when you could forgive.
- 3. At Pentecost, the Spirit enabled the disciples to overcome their fears. What fears were you able to overcome so you could continue the work you were called to do?
