One time, listening to a Catechist teaching about the Beatitudes to his Confirmation class, I heard: “*You think the Ten Commandments are hard? Try living the Eight Beatitudes! To live the Beatitudes is to live a virtuous life, a higher standard than we understand in living the Commandments. While the Commandments tell us what to do or not to do, the Beatitudes tell us how we are to be!*” He continued explaining the difference between doing and being. “In giving the Beatitudes, Jesus reversed the old law of ‘a tooth for a tooth and an eye for an eye.’ Jesus invites us to the opposite... to give our own tooth and our own eye.” That was a different approach to teaching this unique lesson on the Beatitudes. The culture we live in presents countless possibilities, opportunities to practice the Beatitudes. Our children are eager to be virtuous, they want to be good but they need the adults around them to give the example, to pass on their own strengths, courage and determination in the effort to be virtuous and live a holy life. Jesus gave us no bargaining chips, instead an invitation to heroism. *Sr. Clare Sabini*

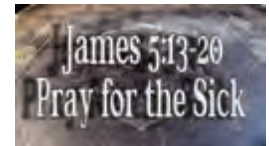

### Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

#### Excerpt from the Gospel for the Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, February 24, 2019 – Luke 6:27-38

Jesus said to his disciples: "To you who hear Me say, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. To the person who strikes you on one cheek, offer the other one as well, and from the person who takes your cloak, do not withhold even your tunic. Give to everyone who asks of you, and from the one who takes what is yours do not demand it back.

#### Commentary:

Today's reading from Luke's "Sermon on the Plain", a parallel of Matthew's Sermon on the Mount, contains the revolutionary command: Love your enemies. Reacting with violence only breeds more violence. The Christian way rises above getting even: "Do good to those who hate you...Do to others what you would have them do to you." Love of enemies makes people truly Godlike! Luke's Jesus tells his listeners to be compassionate as God is compassionate. God has already withheld judgment from us. The reward for our compassion will be beyond all measure!

#### Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Commentary resonates with me?

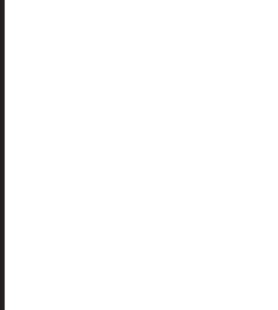
