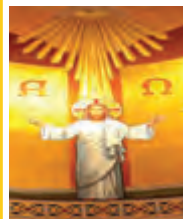

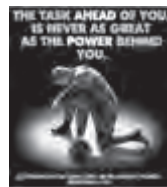
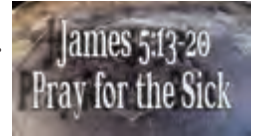

### Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for Proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

#### **Excerpt from the Gospel for Pentecost Sunday, June 9, 2019 John 14:15-16**

"...I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always."

#### **Commentary:**

We celebrate the remarkable feast of Pentecost as the birthday of the Church. The same Spirit that separated the earth from the sky, the sea from the dry land; the same breath that was breathed into Adam now comes to rest on a group of frightened people, and a new being is created. The origins of the Church lay with common people moved by the Spirit of God to follow after Jesus of Nazareth, before they had any idea what was going to be asked of them.

#### **Questions for Reflection and Sharing:**

1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
3. What word or phrase in the Commentary resonates with me?
