BISHOP GALANTE GIVES MONSIGNOR MORGAN PERMISSION TO RETIRE FROM PARISH ADMINISTRATION

It was on April 21, 2003 that I came as pastor to Saint Thomas More parish. I came to you with the strong desire to dedicate the totality of my energies to this faith community.

Nine years ago I felt called to join you on the spiritual journey that began at Baptism. I felt called to journey with you while believing that together we had the ability to go beyond our material bonds. I felt called to lead you on the spiritual journey.

Nine years ago I had no idea where this new phase of my priestly journey would take me. All I knew and sensed at that time was that God was calling me to join you. All I knew was that God was calling me to lead another faith community of God seekers.

These nine years have been a great and learning pastoral experience for me. I found my ministry here at Saint Thomas More to be satisfying and meaningful. I found that this faith community is a place where so many spiritual, wise and thoughtful parishioners nurture their lives.

For nine years I have been privileged to preside at Eucharistic celebrations. I have proclaimed and preached the Word. I have forgiven failings and brokenness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I have blessed homes. I have visited you when you were sick. I sat with those who were dying.

These nine years have been filled with holy and sacred moments. We have strived to build a whole-some and calm centered faith community. We have engaged in powerful dialogue with our souls. We have forged a linkage with God. We have seen God emerge with healings and miracles.

These nine years have connected me with many spiritual seekers. I have met many who know how to turn inward in prayer. They know how to project the fruit of that prayer on to the outside world as they fulfill their varied ministries.

For nine years I have been meeting spiritual seekers throughout the whole parish. They are involved in every phase of parish life. They are the dedicated and committed parish staff. They are those who attend daily and Sunday Eucharistic celebrations.

For nine years I have met spiritual seekers among Parish Pastoral Council members; Parish Finance Council members; Catechists; Eucharistic Ministers; Lectors; Ushers; Altar Servers; Music ministry; Small Group facilitators; Small Christian Community members; Women's Club; Knights of Columbus; Saint Vincent de Paul; Youth ministry leaders; Funsters; Prayer Shawl ministry; Bridge; Golf; Raffle and so many others.

For nine years I have met spiritual seekers in their homes and on the streets. I met them in times of painful illness. I met them in times of difficulty and disappointment. I met them as they strived to cope and realize their better vision for life.

Now Bishop Galante has given me permission to retire as of June 17, 2012. Priests may retire at age 70. I see retirement as one more phase on the spiritual journey. I see it as one more stage in life's journey.

I will continue to do ministry wherever needed. I expect to do some retreat ministry. I expect to do some personal growth ministry and some clinical ministry as I enter deeper into the sacred mystery as that unfolds for me.



Let us rejoice with these children as they partake of this food for their souls, as we all share in the one Bread of Life, Jesus Christ.

Small Christian Community Faith Sharing

Please note that we put the following week's Gospel passage in this space so you can prepare all week for proclamation of the Gospel the following Sunday. Faith Sharing helps ordinary people connect their faith with everyday life experiences.

Excerpt from the Gospel for Sixth Sunday of Easter, May 13, 2012 - John 15:9-17

Jesus said to his disciples: "As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy might be complete. This is my commandment: love one another as I love you... It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you... This I command you: love one another."

Commentary:

God's love for us is both free and costly! It is free in that God first loved and chose us; it is costly in that being loved requires us to "love one another as Christ has loved" us and to "lay down our life" for others.

Questions for Reflection and Sharing:

- 1. What is God saying to me in this Gospel passage?
- 2. What word or phrase in this Gospel speaks to me?
- 3. What word or phrase in the Reflection resonates with me?
