Refugee Support

This month, our Society of St. Vincent de Paul was awarded the Diocesan Operation Rice Bowl grant for their work with refugee families.

The Society is working with two Afghan refugee families and two families seeking asylum from the Congo. Both Afghan families are on the road to independence and stability. Each has obtained their US documentation, secured housing, and are seeking employment. Food-related gift cards and African foods were provided to the two families seeking asylum from the Congo. One family obtained their Social Security card and can now look for employment.

St. Thomas More's parishioners continued support of St. Vincent de Paul allowed them to assist these families as well as many other local families in need.
